



BEHIND THE NAME

The book of Acts in the New Testament contains 28 chapters that include accounts of the early Church including the Ascension, Pentecost, and the Council of Jerusalem. “Acts 29” represents the next unwritten chapter where young people are invited to follow the call of the Holy Spirit to be fervent disciples of Christ.

OVERVIEW

ACTS29 is missionary discipleship formation for any 10th, 11th, or 12th grader who is looking to grow in faith, charity, and wisdom. ACTS29 provides opportunities to grow in servant leadership in the Catholic Church. These opportunities include:

- Monthly formation and training
- Co-leading EDGE middle school youth ministry, Emmaus Small Groups, and Life Nights
- Assisting with Confirmation Retreats (confirmed seniors only)
- Retreats, pilgrimages, and conferences
- Safe Environment Training certification

COST

There is no cost upfront for ACTS29; however, there may be additional fees during the year for special events and other formation materials.

SCHEDULE

ACTS29 generally meets every first Tuesday evening of the month 6:45-8:45pm in the Life Teen Cafe for formation and training. There are some exceptions including special events and the first formation night in September.
